



LIMITED-TIME GAS GRANT



AFAS is offering a one-time **\$150 grant for Airmen and Guardians** to help offset higher fuel costs.

Who Can Apply

Airmen & Guardians who meet the following criteria:

- ★ Active Duty (*Ranks E1-E6*)
- ★ Active Guard Reserve (AGR) – on 15+ day orders (*Ranks E1-E6*)
- ★ Title 10/32 Guard/Reserve – on 15+ day orders (*Ranks E1-E6*)

Application Period

- ★ **Applications Open:** May 11, 2026
- ★ **Applications Close:** May 15, 2026 *or until funds are exhausted*

Program Details

- ★ **Type of Assistance:** Grant (*no repayment required*)
- ★ **Amount:** \$150 (*one-time*)
- ★ **Use of Funds:** Gas for your vehicle
- ★ **Payment Method:** Direct deposit via Zelle or ACH

Documents Required

- ★ **Military ID** (*copy of front and back*)
- ★ **Leave and Earnings Statement** (*End of month LES*)
- ★ **Orders** (*for AGR and Title 10/32 Guard/Reserve*)



How to Apply

1. Visit afas.org and select "Request Assistance"
2. Log into the Application Portal (*or create an account*)
3. Click on "Assistance" to begin your application
4. Select "Vehicle Expenses", then "POV Gas"
5. Complete the application and upload all required documents

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Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q1: Who qualifies for this program?

Active-duty Airmen and Guardians (Ranks E1-E6), Active Guard Reserve (AGR) on 15+ day orders (Ranks E1-E6), and Title 10/32 Guard/Reserve on 15+ day orders (Ranks E1-E6).

Q2: How much can I receive?

Eligible applicants receive a one-time \$150 gas grant.

Q3: What can the funds be used for?

This grant is intended to help cover fuel/gas expenses for your primary vehicle.

Q4: Can I use the funds for anything other than gas?

This grant is intended to help eligible service members offset the rising cost of gas.

Q5: Do I have to repay these funds?

No. This is a grant and does not require repayment.

Q6: How will I receive the funds if my application is approved?

Approved funds are deposited directly to the service member via Zelle or ACH.

Q7: How long does it take to get approved?

Most applications are processed within 3–5 business days, depending on completeness and document verification. You can check the status of your application anytime online through the Application Portal.

Q8: How long does it take to receive payment after approval?

Most payments are made within 1-3 business days of approval (and may be sooner).

Q9: Can I apply more than once?

No. This is a one-time grant per eligible service member.

Q10: How long is this program available?

This is a limited-time program. It will remain open through the application period or until the program cap is reached.

Q11: Can I combine this with other AFAS assistance?

Yes, you may still apply for other forms of AFAS assistance if eligible. Each case is reviewed separately.

Q12: Is a budget required?

No. A budget is not required for this program.

Q13: What happens if I submit an incomplete application?

Incomplete applications may be returned for missing documentation, which can delay processing or approval. Ensure all required documents are included before submitting.
